 Humphrey Broadstock (39) *b. West Brom. labourer*, was living with wife Sarah (38) children Sarah (17), William (15) Jemmima (10) Prudence (8) Elizabeth (5) Humphrey (3) & Susanna 10mths, *at 47 Longfield Street, Aspull, Lancs*

In the 1891 census;
 Joseph Broadstock (32) *b. West Brom. labourer*, was living with wife Annie (38) *b. West Brom.* children Jemmima (9) & Joel (3) *at 53 Longfield Street, Aspull, Lancs*
 Also living with them at the time was Susannah Beardsmore age 17, and is shown as his sister-in-law..

In the 1901 census;
 Humphrey Broadstock (49) *b. West Brom. labourer*, was living with wife Sarah (48) children Humphrey (3) Susanna (10) & George (8), *at 35 Leeds Street, Aspull, Lancs*
 Elizabeth Broadstock aged 15, is a servant and living at 241 Scholes, Wigan, the home of Joseph T. Gee, 37, local magistrate and provisions merchant.

In 1911 census;
 Enoch Olerenshaw (46), miner, was living wife Sarah and stepson George Broadstock (17), miner, in *315 Whelley, Wigan.*
 Humphrey Broadstock (22), labourer, and new wife Clara (19) are boarders with Thomas Showell at *233 Whelley, Wigan.*
 Susannah Broadstock (20), live-in servant at, *Wigan Coal & Iron Offices, Kirkless, Wigan.*

In 1881;
 John Broadstock (50) *b. West Brom. coalminer*, was living with wife Mary (35) *b. West Brom* and children, James (20), Sarah (6), Amos (4) and John (1) in *16 Bull Lane, West Bromwich.*

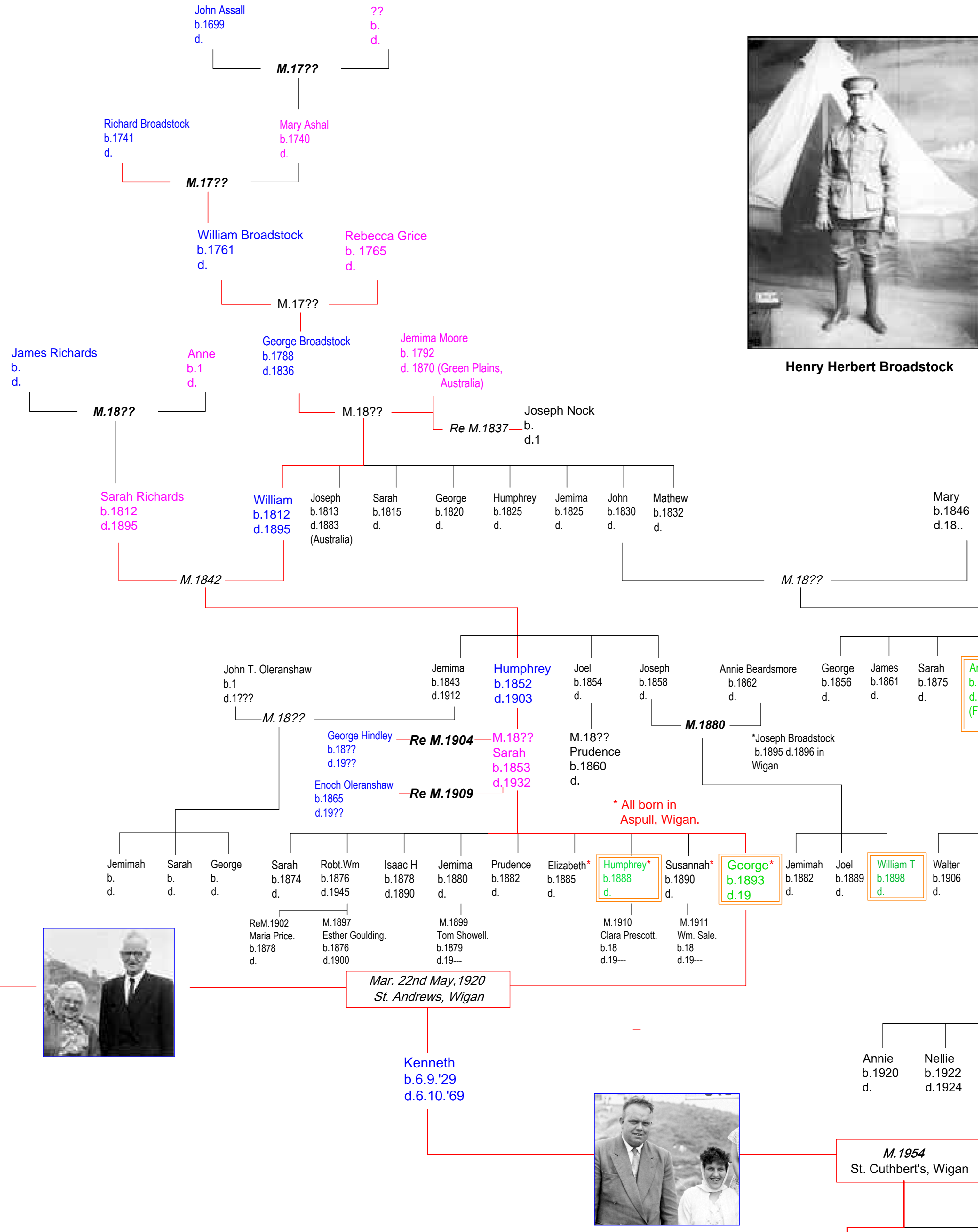
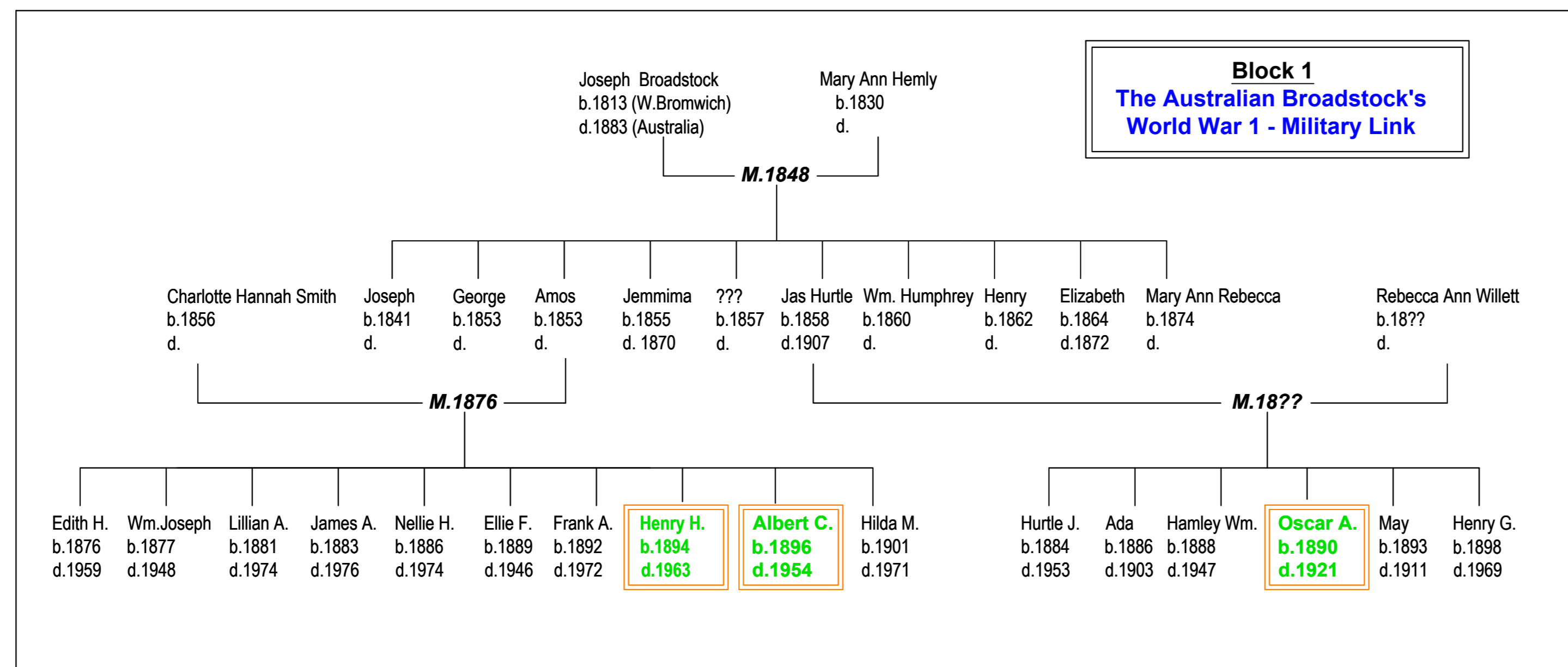
In 1891;

In 1901;

In 1917;
 Amos Broadstock is noted to have been killed in France/ Flanders on 26th March 1917. Also noted that he was born in West Bromwich but now had resided in Pentre, Flint.

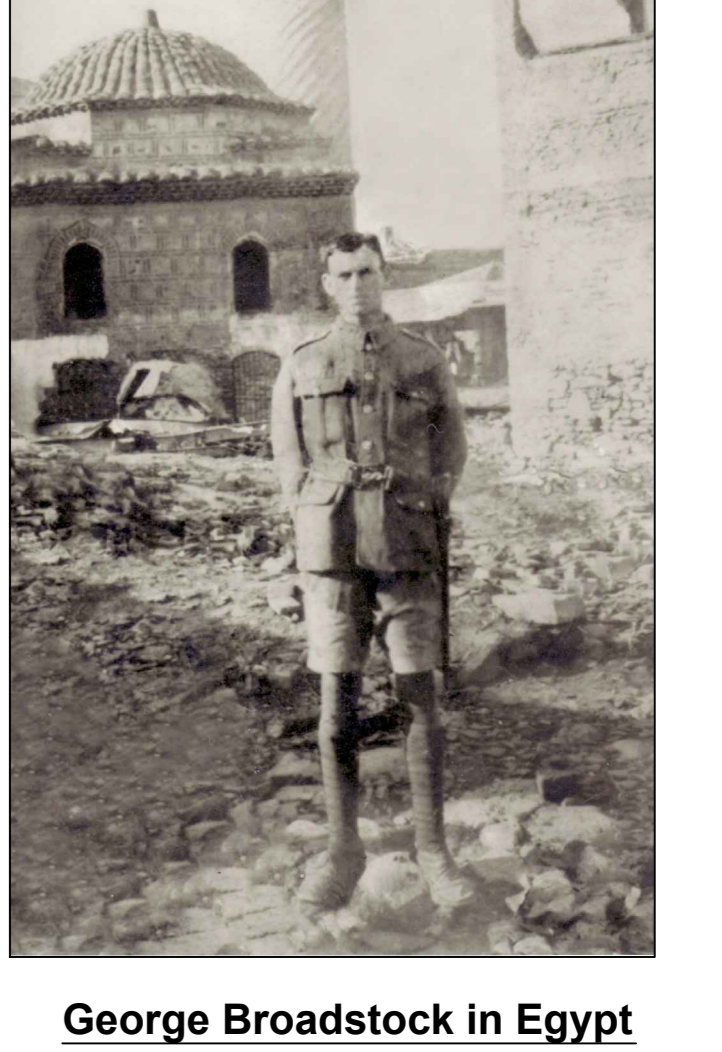
Amos Broadstock b.1876, W. Bromwich - Private, S. Staffs. Regt. No.10558

 *Soldiers usually went into Labour Corps if they had been wounded and not fit for frontline duties.

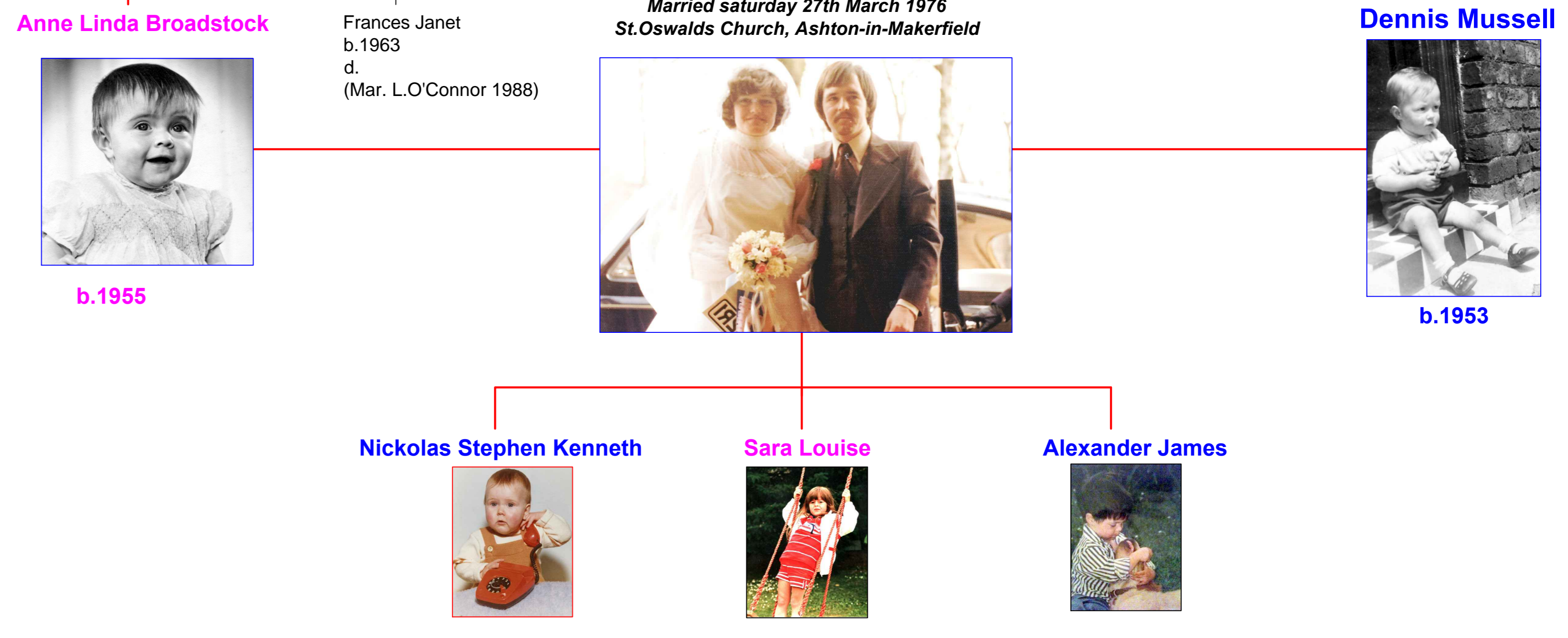
George Broadstock** b.1893, Wigan - Private, Liverpool Regt. No.33308
